#### **NOTES FROM THE SHOPS**

The tender for #4 went to the paint shop but, subject to further examination, may need a new drop plate. Not a big job but unexpected, however, safety first. Steam trials at the end of March or early April ready for another season.

The "K D Fortner" had a major rebuild of the emergency boiler feed pump and is awaiting the plumbers to re-pack the gland on the axle pump, otherwise, also ready for steam when the weather permits. A bit of a problem with the ash pan dump pin caused naughty words to be spoke, seems some bright spark put it in from the wrong side and the pipe fitters erected an injector in front of it calling for some fancy work with a grinder which was quicker than waiting for the prima donnas to dismantle the injector. Needless to say the dump pin is in the right way round now.

#3 may get a new paint job but it isn't a priority, perhaps the glaziers can be persuaded to replace the windows.

#4 and "Invicta" went to Woodstock in January in company with a Hunslett from St. Mary's.

The Climax the "R K Davis" arrived at the shops on Saturday January 24<sup>th</sup> for re-gauging, a new grate and the fitting and plumbing of an emergency boiler feed pump. As the "K D Fortner" is still under the erecting shop hoist it may be necessary to use the repair track hoist out in the cold to drop the trucks so that the wheel/axle assembly can be removed for the wheels to be pulled off the axles, hopefully the old axles can be re-worked which would be half the time of making new ones.

Work on the boiler for the Baldwin in the new build shop progresses steadily and is now at the stage of blanking off the various bushings for a 1<sup>st</sup> hydraulic test.

The Tentative Steaming Schedule for 2015 has been drawn up, as usual subject to weather. There's lots of Saturdays leaving Sundays for birthday parties, family re-unions, car clubs etc.
