NOTE FROM THE SHOPS

STOP THE PRESS.

A breakthrough in labour negotiations could lead to an early settlement and a return to work.

A new one year contract was narrowly ratified by the shop crafts at the end of February.

A return to work on an "as required' basis meant that the wheel drop was not immediately available for No.4 so it was positioned under the big crane and lifted off its wheels, this ties up the heavy lift road so no "new build' is expected before the third week of July.

The driving wheels have been successfully re-tyred and profiled, the coupled wheels await profiling, No4 should be re-wheeled by the second week of April with the connecting and coupling rods and the valve gear re-assembled by the end of the month, fortunately all the motion work was re-bushed last winter and is still in good condition. The next job will be the making and fitting of new automatic drain cocks then to steam test.

6009, the Sarnia locomotive, will be next for attention as it needs new piston rings which means removing the rear covers from the cylinders c/w guide bars and crossheads etc.

Management has decreed there will be no overtime for the foreseeable future with premium pay. However, time may be taken off in lieu of.
