There is still some fine tuning to be done with level and line but it is operable under a slow order.

In a rare moment of inter-departmental co-operation, the need for a loco to run light to check super elevations and consolidation along with opportunity to indulge the traffic department for some driver training, ended with a resounding success for all concerned.

The old track bed is being cleaned up as time permits but is not a priority.

The B&B gang moved the station southward rather than try to repair the damage caused by the track re-alignment.

A short piece of track still needs some fettling when the Killdeer eggs hatch, which hopefully will have happened by the time you read this. Driver Symington is added to the roster for Komoka Fest which will ease the problem of staff shortage.


