Sat. September 14th, Sun. September 22st, Sat. September 28th

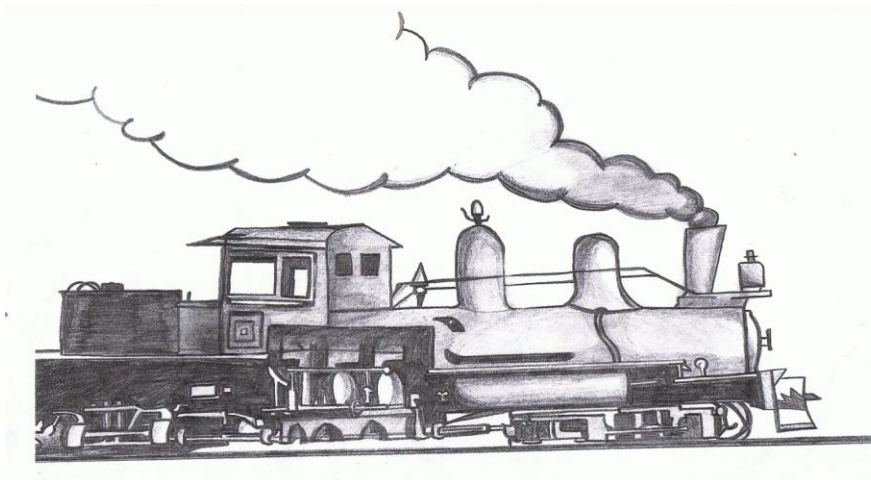
October 2013 Schedule
