#### FROM TRACKSIDE

Preparations are being made to ease the long drag out of "Murray's Landing" and raise the dip at the other end of the station as any over limit load caused braking problems, although no mishaps occurred there were reports of "signal passed at danger" (SPAD's). With the extra summer help it is expected to complete the work by the third week of July

Resident number 4 ran well for Komoka Fest and number 3 filled in while a quick visit to the stable for number 4 for ash dumping and flue sweeping at mid=day was needed.

A "hit'n miss" cylinder lubricator drive caused some anxious moments but the secret formula steam oil saved the day and the roller clutch has been replaced ready for July 1st (Canada Day).

A small quantity of soft coal (Pocahontas?) was discovered in a dark corner and is proving useful when raising steam from cold and when an extra effort is needed, although it doesn't clinker and cause damage to the fire bars as Anthracite tends to do it is not popular with the crew as it calls for more firing and burns with a lot of smoke

A new boiler for number 4 has been started and will be installed over the winter subject to hydraulic and stem tests, it is expected the new one will be more user friendly as the present one is resentful of clumsy handling.

The vegetation control crew have had a break recently as the heat has deterred the grass and dandelions from becoming a nuisance.

The lack of rain is giving cause for concern, there is enough water on hand for July 1st. City water would be a desperation move
